

Covid-19 Policy for Olivet Kids on Campus

The safety of the children is taken very seriously at Olivet Bible Church. We have security measures in place for the safety of our children during the service. We have created some new policies to avoid the spread of this pandemic.

1. We expect parents to keep their children home if they or anyone in their household are experiencing symptoms that could test positive.
 - Fever or chills
 - Cough; shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Fatigue; muscle or body aches, and/or headache
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Sore throat
 - Congestion or runny nose
 - Nausea, vomiting and/or diarrhea
2. We expect that the children will be wearing masks and willing to use sanitizer when needed.
3. Children will be given carpet squares that will be their assigned space during Olivet Kids.
4. Children will be given their own craft supplies, including crayons, markers, glue or any other item used for crafts. They will be kept separate for every week's use.
5. Olivet Kids teachers and volunteers are expected to stay home with communication to the Children's Ministry Director of any symptoms listed above.
6. Expectations for Olivet Kids teachers and volunteers include wearing a mask when on campus, as is the expectation for being in the building for services and small group meetings as well.
7. Olivet Kids teachers and volunteers will use sanitizer when needed.
8. Olivet Kids teachers and volunteers will maintain classroom management with reminders or if needed, notifying the parent/guardian to pick up their child during service.
9. All areas will be sanitized prior to and after Olivet Kids meeting times.
10. At this time, we will not be providing snacks as it is not realistic to do so with a mask policy in place.
